The Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences is a 6-year program preparing students to become leading pharmacists in their communities. The programs are designed to encourage students to think and act independently through the planning and management of a variety of projects. As a supplement to the conventional pharmaceutical studies, students learn a wide range of additional subjects, such as nutrition studies, social welfare, nursing, health care for the elderly and self-medication.

The curriculum aims to equip students with the specialized skills and knowledge required to serve patients of all ages. Students are mentored by professors in all aspects of their time at university from their studies to everyday life.

Internships and Research Program ---A Graduation Exam

Graduate research work, specialized programs for total management of drug therapy, consulting, regulatory sciences, management, school pharmacists, drug informations, and exercise for integrated studies
